

In 2023, the College of Food Industry "Elena Doamna" from Galati became a co-partner in the Erasmus+ project "Travel, Learn and Taste the World"- 2023-1-PL01-KA210-VET000152029, with coordinating school from Poland and Portugal as partner.

The main goal of the project is "cooperation in the field of promoting cultural heritage, national and regional cuisine, as well as creating vocational skills in the field of gastronomy and communication in English". In these conditions, the main advantages of this project were communication in English of the participants, and the acquisition of professional skills specific to the gastronomic field through cooperation regarding the promotion of the cultural and culinary heritage of the host countries.

During the week of May 20th -24th 2024, the international meeting of the Erasmus+ project took place where teachers and students from the Romanian college, six teachers and six students from Poland and Portugal had been involved within the workshops organized in the laboratories of the Faculties in Galati, in the school's biochemistry and microbiology laboratories, but also in the school's pilot microproduction stations.
